Master Sommelier **Emmanuel Kemiji**

Born in the United States, raised in Spain and England, and a Graduate of the University of California at Davis, Emmanuel has become one of the most highly regarded Master Sommeliers in the world of Viticulture. In North America today, there are only 105 professionals who have earned the title of Master Sommelier and of them, Kemiji is one of only nine to pass the Master Sommelier

test in London, England on his first try.

In 1995 Kemiji started his first winery Miura Vineyards in the interest of expanding upon his study of Viticulture and Oenology while at Davis. Shortly thereafter Kemiji began Candela in 1998, Almvs in 2000, Antiqv²s in 2001, and two projects abroad in Spain – Arrels in 2003 and Clos Pissarra in 2005. Additionally, Kemiji has won several awards for his efforts. In 2000 he was honored with “Sommelier of the Year” by the California Restaurant Writers Association and in 2006 he received the Wine Industry Achievement Award. We can hardly contain ourselves as Emmanuel shares selections from several of his vineyards for this event. It is sure to be a memorable evening!



Celia Tejada

Born and raised in a small mountain town of in the province of Santander in Northern Spain and a graduate of the International School of Design in Bilbao, Celia Tejada is most importantly the creative genius behind Tejada Vines. Having spent 25 years in the design industry in every facet from becoming the Vice-President of Design and Brand Direction in William-Sonoma’s Pottery Barn division to developing her very own clothing design company, Tejada put her varied skills to work in her wines along with her siblings and business partners, Ibo and Nina Tejada.

It was Tejada's love of food and wine that originally led her and the family to purchase a modest 79 acre property, 130 miles out of San Francisco in Lake County, to develop a family retreat with a rural feeling and the Tejada’s added the vineyard to help teach future generations of Tejadas the values of working the land together and watching the fruits of their labor, most literally, flourish in a harmonious connection with Mother Nature and human being.

And so it was, in 2000, five acres of vines were planted at the base of the waterfall on the

property, and most naturally embodying their Spanish heritage; Tempranillo for its strength and passion and Garnacha for its sensuality and softness--Tejada Vines was born. Ever since its inception, the Tejadas have maintained total control over the ways and means in which their wines are produced. With it, what has come forth is a beautiful representation of the Tejada family spirit and character that we are excited to be a part of for this wonderful evening.
